

Relationships and Sex Education Statement

The governors at St. Paschal Baylon Catholic Primary School have adopted the *Journey In Love* programme to support the non-statutory Relationships and Sex Education across the school from Reception to Year 6. The programme of study is authentic to the teaching of the Catholic Church. Below is a brief outline of the content of the programme.

Year Group	Objectives
Nursery: Wonder at God's Love*	Know that God made us and our world. Know that we are important to him.
Reception: God loves each of us in our uniqueness	Know that there is no one more special than me. Know that God made me and loves me as I am.
Year 1: We meet God's love in our family	Know that as we grow we are loved by our family. Know that as we grow we are also loved by God's family.
Year 2: We meet God's love in the community	Know that the Church is God's family. Know that I am part of that family too.
Year 3: How we live in love	Understand what make a good friend. Know that God is our best friend.
Year 4: God loves us in our differences	Know that God has made us different from one another. Know that God loves us in our differences.
Year 5:	Know that as we grow we will become different in our bodies, feelings and love of God.

Year 6: The wonder of God's love in creating new life	Know that we are made to love and to be loved. Learn the proper ways in which we show our love for one another and for God.

*Nursery content will be taught in Reception.

As part of our commitment to you, we will hold a meeting annually for the parents and carers of children across the school to discuss the programme. As parents, you have the right to withdraw your child from this aspect of the curriculum. However, this is not to be confused with curriculum Science, which is statutory.
