Judaism Week

This week, as part of the RE curriculum and Come and See programme, the children have spent time studying Judaism.

The children have learnt about Rosh Hashanah, Shabbat, Hanukah, explored Jewish artefacts and even made Challah bread! Year 3 will visit the Synagogue next week as part of their 'Places of Worship' topic.

The children have learnt how members of the Jewish community live as a family and how they worship. Just like Jesus showed respect for those within and outside his own faith community, the children have learnt to respect the beliefs and traditions of others.

Parents, please share this with friends and neighbours. For your information, from Tuesday 12th September both the reception class and Year 7 (secondary) admissions application windows open. Parents can now apply online.

Reception Class – closing date for on-line applications is 15th January 2018 – St. Paschal Baylon school form must also be completed – please ask at the school office.

Secondary Year 7 – you will receive direct from school a unique coded online letter; apply for your child's secondary school place from Tuesday 12th September. Closing date for on-line applications is 31st October 2017. For Catholic schools you will also need to complete their own admission forms.

All literature directs parents to apply online. Please note that children who are **not** Liverpool Local Authority residents must apply to their home local authority as per the local co-ordinated admissions arrangements.

WHAT'S BEEN HAPPENING IN SCHOOL THIS WEEK?

RECEPTION:

Wow, what a magical week we've had! On Monday, after our 'Remarkable Reading Assembly', a witch's hat, broomstick, cauldron and ingredients appeared in our classroom. There was also a letter from Winnie the witch and the letter told us to make a magic potion that would help us with our reading and writing. As we made the magic potion, we said the magic spell "Iggerty, Ziggerty, Zaggerty, Zoom!" In English, we have been retelling the story of Room on the Broom using the actions. Why not ask your child to show you this at home? We have labelled cauldrons with initial sounds; we have been building and reading green words and pairing the words that rhyme. In Maths, we have continued to explore the number one, focusing on partitioning using a whole part diagram and writing the word one. In RE, we have been learning about Judaism. We looked at some Jewish artefacts and learned about the story of Hanukkah. In our busy time areas, we have made witches potions, witches faces out of 2D shapes and we used tweezers to get spiders out of their webs to develop our fine motor skills. What a busy week!

YEAR ONE:

This week, Y1 have been showing off their creativity through various subjects! We painted pictures in R.E. and made animals in our Topic lesson. In English, we have used our research at home and school to help us to write a non-chronological report about Guinea Pigs. We are still getting used to writing our sentences independently and checking that they make sense! We have explored addition in maths, through number bonds, part whole diagrams, addition stories and number sentences. On Thursday, we enjoyed a sunny Autumn Walk through Court Hey Park. We collected some items, which we will be looking at back in class next week.

YEAR TWO

This week in English Year 2 have been looking at Non-Chronological Reports and as a whole class we discussed what features are included. We have also been finding out information about the place where we live including geographical location, the history and things we can do in Liverpool. In Maths we have been learning about simple subtraction using methods such as crossing out, number line and column method to solve questions. In R.E we have been learning about Judaism including what happens during Shabbat. We even got to make some Challah bread thanks to Chef Terry!

YEAR THREE:

It was Judaism week and the children learnt about special places in the Jewish faith, particularly the Synagogue. The pupils; explored specific symbols within the Synagogue and will see this in person when they visit the Synagogue on Monday; a visit we are all looking forward to.

We changed focus in English this week when we switched from a fiction unit – Folktales, to a non-fiction unit – Biographies. The children learnt about the lives of Lionel Messi, David Beckham, Roald Dahl, Mr Gowans and Mrs Ashton (the mystery people!).

On Thursday, we continued our search, locating where we live using google maps and street view. Hopefully, the children will now be able to use these skills at home.

YEAR FOUR:

Year 4 have had a fantastic week: creating animations in the style of 'Finding Nemo' in their Computing lesson; finishing off their red and green light circuits in Science/Topic; finding out all about the Hindenburg disaster in English lessons.

YEAR FIVE:

This week Year 5 have explored the Jewish faith. They have experienced what it is like to celebrate the feast of Passover, and the Exodus Story. To reflect on the meal the children created their very own Seder Plate, discussing the meaning and symbol of each food.

As Legends comes to an end, the children have planned and written their own. They have worked very hard, been creative and produced excellent stories, which may even overtake Michael Morporgo! We are extremely impressed. They have really enjoyed this genre of Literature.

In maths the children have continued with addition and subtraction, working hard and challenging themselves to solve problems.

A fabulous, creative, motivated and hard working week. Well done Year 5.

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YEAR SIX:

Year 6 have been designing a revision app for SATs in ICT. This involved planning links to other pages as well as inputting the information. We concluded our action stories and we were extremely pleased with the quality of work our children have produced. We look forward to beginning our biographies topic. In maths we looked at word problems and how a bar model can be used to solve them. It was Judaism week this week in R.E, and our children produced information booklets about Rosh Hashanah. In Science, we had fun investigating how birds have adapted their beaks over time. Ask us all about our experiment with tweezers and sweets!
