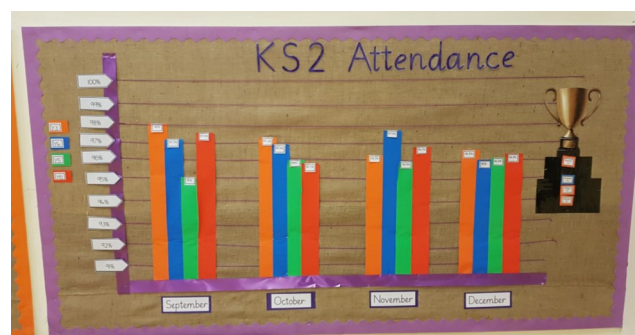
Marvelous Maths ambassadors
