Last year our Maths ambassadors were excellent in making maths everywhere in the school. They also were a huge reason for us getting Gold in the LCQM,

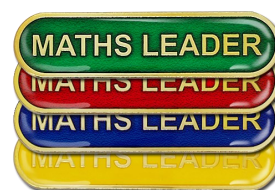
Are you confident with numbers? Able to work resiliently when solving problems? Then this opportunity is for you!
