There were multiple solutions to the problem and the children had to think about a range of factors.

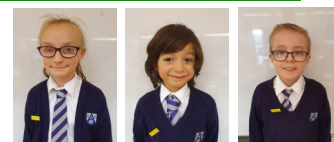
One parent said, "It was nice seeing the children so engaged with the activity and I got to see how my child works it out in their book."
