Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope that you and your families are all safe and well.

This week the staff have been phoning the children in their class. This will continue next week for those who have not yet received the call. I hope that your children have enjoyed the opportunity to speak to their class teacher and that you as parents have found this helpful. The teachers have really enjoyed speaking to the children again.

Home Learning:

It has come to my attention that some parents did not realise that each week there are **two** separate documents added to each Year Group page on the website.

To find these on the school website:

1. Click on the "Year Group" Tab.
2. Click on the Year Group that your child is in.
3. Scroll to near the bottom of the page and you will see the Learning Projects and Mini Projects with that specific week beginning date on. (These are two separate documents.)
4. Open both links to see the mini project for the week on one document and all of the suggested Maths, Spelling, Reading and Writing activities on the second document.

The mini project is usually based on a particular theme.

The second document is an A4 page divided into 4 or 5 sections. As mentioned above, this has activities linked to Mathematics, Spelling, Reading and Writing. Key Stage 2 will also have a Rights Respecting School task.

Each Monday we will continue to add the two documents to each Year Group page. As before, it is up to you as parents to decide how much you would like your child to do. Children in Reception will find their activities on Tapestry. Here you can also find the links to watch the Read, Write, Inc Phonics video clips. It is also worth looking at the News section on the website for additional tasks and information.

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Re-opening for other year groups:

This will take the same format as last week. On Monday 15th June we will be informed by Liverpool City Council if they believe the city is ready to re-open for specific year groups. If this is the case, Year 6 were identified as the first year that would return to a primary school in Liverpool, possibly on Monday 22nd June. Once I receive this information next Monday, I will share this with parents immediately.

Key Workers:

Each Monday a new survey will be released on the “News” section of the website for key worker parents. This is to book a place in school for your child for the following week. Each week the survey will stay open until **Wednesday at 11.00am**. If you do not complete the survey by this time, your child will not be able to access the school the following week. This is because all staffing levels are linked directly to the responses from the survey. I need to inform staff by Wednesday afternoon of their working timetable for the following week. I also need to ensure that our plan for the following week incorporates all City Council guidance, including the 2m social distancing rule in class. Our school will continue to be open from 8.30am – 3.20pm for children of key workers.

Finally, I would like to thank you again for your patience as we all wait together to find out further information regarding the opening of schools to more pupils.
