P.E Kits

Starting this term children will wear their P.E. Kits to school on the day that they have P.E. This will avoid the children getting their clothes mixed up and significantly reduce the amount of bags that need to be exchanged between home and school.

Children in Year 1 and Reception already have school tracksuits. This was going to be phased in over time so that all year groups would have a school tracksuit. We will update you in the coming weeks if our supplier would be able to provide the opportunity for parents of older children to purchase a tracksuit. In the meantime, when the weather is too cold for your child just to wear their P.E. shorts and T-shirt, they will be able to wear any tracksuit to school.

- It is really important that you aim to arrive at school at the allocated time. This is important to try and reduce the number of children and parents on site and outside the school gates at any one time.
- As previously stated, younger siblings will enter the school at the same time as the oldest sibling in their family. This allows the parent to leave the site immediately and reduce crowding.
